Coffee House Conversations

As the 1st Pres Community Outreach Committee discussed the direction we wanted to head, Kay Mills perfectly summed up our intention - "To enhance our faith through understanding and reaching out to our neighbors with Love First".

The concept of our church having a more visible presence in our community as a body of Christians that truly Love First and welcome all is our goal. But there is a level of understanding that needs to be reached before we may be able to empathize with those who may face challenges in life that differ from ours.

Thus, the concept of *Coffee House Conversations* was born. A place to share coffee and stories, learn about other's struggles and gain understandings through human interactions.

Our very first event will happen Monday, May 1 in Krueger Hall at 5:30 pm. We'll have coffee, treats, and a guest speaker from the Executive Director of NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness) Idaho. Beth Markley, joining us from Boise, will talk about the stigma related to mental health, how to talk about mental health, where to find resources and best to offer support.
