

Union Gospel Mission

Mission Committee In the News

The Union Gospel Mission facility, located in Coeur d'Alene. ID is for women and their children and offers a safe and healing environment for those experiencing the devastating impact of poverty, homelessness, abuse, addiction, and domestic violence. Assistance available includes legal, dental and medical. Additionally, there are educational opportunities such as the ability to complete a GED diploma, classes including cooking and finance with plans for classes in massage therapy, anatomy and kinesiology. This summer (July), a new thrift store is opening which will provide vocational training. Volunteers staff most of these endeavors.

Finding sobriety is challenging and the staff has developed a five-phase program based on truth and love. While Faith is not required, the administration and



volunteers model and express the love of God daily with the hope the residents will feel that love and find a new

path that supports their recovery.

The women/children may stay in the program for two years with the option to move to nearby supportive housing for an additional two years. They must remain addiction free. A local minister has offered to work with any who have completed their four years and have expressed the need for ongoing support.

We are happy to report that 87% of donations go directly to services with 13% toward administrative and fundraising costs. We are so fortunate to have a place like this in CdA. It is clean, cheerful, and well run.




Let the little children come unto me! Who said that? Carley has started a new series focused on how Jesus loves everyone! Listen to her message here.

Adventures in Caring Details!



If your child would like to earn their scholarship, they will need to participate in the Adventures of Caring "Give Love, Get Love" program. I have a list started for the students who I know are going to be participating to get their scholarship. Please contact me to be added to the list if you have not already done so.

Action items and key details

- Inform Carley that you would like your child(ren) to participate in the program by MAY 1st. They must complete the project in order to receive their scholarship! When registering your child on the Camp Lutherhaven website you will be prompted to enter your donating church and the amount. We will be contributing 50% of camp costs for children who attend camp during the week of August 8th through the 13th AND who complete the Adventures in Caring scholarship program.
- During the first week of May, I will mail the participants a package with the record sheet and some business cards that they can give to the individuals they decide to show love to by volunteering for them in some way.
- The Acts of Caring (three volunteer opportunities) need to be completed, and the very simple form (see attached) needs to be turned in to me or the church office by August 1st. We ask that the children fills out their own form using their best penmanship. If they are not writing yet, they can draw a picture of their volunteer activity. These record sheets will be displayed in Krueger Hall as part of our Missions Outreach because that is exactly what your children are doing, being missionaries for Jesus right here in our community!
- We know you are busy and we don't want to add more to your plate, thus, we will be offering three volunteer opportunities for your children to use as their Acts of Caring. They can decide to help friends, family, or neighbors too!

- 1. May 19th at 5:30 pm in the gym. We will be making cards for the Deacons to use for our elderly members who cannot currently make it to church. Please plan on picking your children up (or you can stay and help too!) by 6:00 pm as we have Adventure Kids' Club that evening.
- 2. June 6th during church we will be holding a food drive. Your children can help gather the supplies before the church service. Please arrive by 8:30 am to participate in this volunteer opportunity.
- 3. June 27th immediately following the church service, we will be handing out water and cheering on Ironman racers! During the service, we will make signs to use while cheering on the racers reflecting our Love 1st mission.
