International Gospel Missions December Mission Team Update

Togo is a small West African coastal country made up of just over 22,000 square miles. It is one of Africa's smallest countries, with a population of an estimated 8



million people. A primarily French speaking country and a former French colony, Togo's religion consists of indigenous beliefs along with Christianity and Islam.

1st Pres supports Pastor Edoh Paul Assignon in Togo through International Gospel Missions. Their mission is to create cooperative relationships where local churches, organizations, and individuals prayerfully, financially, and physically support workers and ministries in addition to spreading the Word. Pastor Paul has enormous energy and

enthusiasm for bringing people to Christ. He sends 1st Pres periodic letters about progress in his area, and the churches he is planting there. Many young people have been saved through his inspirational work and he asks for prayers for the new Christians who have found God through his ministry.

Pastor Paul and his family recently contracted malaria and continue to struggle with health issues as they recover. They ask for our prayers for recovery and healing.
