As members of the Finance and Stewardship committees, we want to thank you for your



financial faithfulness in 2021. Each year our two committees work hard to estimate the church's giving and expenses for the coming year. The budgeting process has been difficult the past two years due to unforeseen challenges worldwide. Through it all, the members of 1st Pres came through in numerous ways. Thanks to the loyal and faithful members of our church and their financial commitments over the years, we have been able to meet all of

our current financial obligations as well as plan for our church's future financial security. Your generosity has truly humbled us.

Our giving income through November shows we are running behind about \$30,000 of our expected 2021 giving of our budgeted amount of \$575,000.
