Union Gospel Mission or UGM is a healing community for men and women in

Spokane and just for women in Coeur d'Alene. Each is accepted for whom they are, but are people who want to change from a life of brokenness due to addiction, homelessness, and bad choices. Their backstory must be honestly told to recover. The crisis center for women is located in Spokane.

longer you can be within a healing community, the better it will be. The women can stay in this environment up to two years. Classes will be provided for GED, cooking, auto shop, thrift shopping, and financial coursework. After two years, they can be placed in apartments built on the premises. While living here, the women can work in the real world and yet be close by for counseling, if needed. A chaplain is available to hear and assist if problems arise. A great need for UGM now is to purchase more land next door to

The women of Coeur d'Alene making this choice may have their children join them in a beautiful and clean dormitory-housing situation. In this safe housing, they receive delicious meals, clothing, dental, medical, and psychological care. Legal assistance is offered in Spokane. Religious attendance is not required, but they are taught daily of the love of Jesus. Each volunteer must also live a Christ-centered example.

With change comes healing and a sense of belonging. Dr. John Wolfe said that the

build more apartments. Housing availability is difficult due to expense and, unfortunately, could lead to returning to their old communities of drugs and bad living.

The annual report for all of UGM shows that 88% of their revenue goes into the programs without government help. They have given 192,144 meals, 101,292 nights of shelter, 2411 medical visits, 215 adults and 70 children in recovery programs, and 629 found jobs.
