#### Check-in/ Check-out

We are excited to introduce a better and safer check-in/check-out routine for our

church families. Starting Sunday, April 3rd, we will be asking all families to check in at the Adventure Kids' room (next to the Nursery in Krueger Hall) before heading into the Sanctuary for worship. When your family checks in, each child will get a name tag and the parents will get a corresponding check-out sticker. Then you and your children will go into the Sanctuary. When the bell is rung, all children will come down for Kids' Corner, and then head to their classrooms just as before. After their lessons upstairs, our wonderful teachers will bring all of the children downstairs to the Adventure Kids' room. We will be there waiting for you to pick them up. Please bring your check-out sticker as it will now be required for check-out.

If you forget to check in your children before service, or you are running late, you can join us at the front of the Sanctuary for Kids' Corner and check in your children then. That way they can join us for Sunday School! We are excited about keeping our children safe and equipping our church to grow.
