Staff of Hope March Mission Team Update

Staff of Hope has a threeprong mission



in Southeast Kenya, Africa, consisting of a year-round water well-drilling program, an adult ministry to area pastors, and the Oloile Secondary Boarding School all within view of Mount Kilimanjaro to the south. It's an area of poor, semi-arid farmland that has been hit hard by COVID

We Are Serving Ecumenical Lunch

Thursday, April 6

Please sign-up in Krueger Hall to help with this wonderful community outreach. We and recent droughts, shutting down all Staff of Hope activities in 2019. The Oloile School reopened in 2021 with a student population of 120, 50% boys and 50% girls. Our gifting to this mission partner helps pay for school capital programs and a portion of those students who can't pay for their tuition.

The adult pastor ministry is just now restarting its meeting program.

Unfortunately, the deep well-water drilling rig and associated equipment suffered a major mechanical failure in 2019, putting this part of the Staff of Hope program on indefinite hold. Estimates to repair the drilling rig are in excess of \$75,000, with needed parts requiring long lead times of many months before delivery.

Rev. Jeff Spainhour of Durham, NC, is the co-founder of Staff of Hope, and has been graciously sharing how Staff of Hope has been working to meet God's calling.
