Union Gospel Mission May Mission Team Update

Since 1951, the Union Gospel Mission has partnered with the Inland Northwest to reach the poor and homeless with the love and the power of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Our purpose is for them to become lifelong God-dependent, contributing members of society.

UGM offers long-term recovery programs for people dealing with overwhelming personal issues such as addiction, domestic violence, or a criminal record. Recognizing that permanent change takes place at the heart level, these programs address the underlying thoughts, feelings, and beliefs that drive destructive behaviors.

UGM opened the Center for Women and Children in Coeur d'Alene in September 2012. At the Center, women and their children find healing for their brokenness and the tools and direction they need to live in the freedom Jesus offers.

UGM Works - A Success Story!

Megan is almost in phase 4 of our UGM LIFE Recovery program. She came to UGM from the Boise Correctional Center where she was doing time for a drug charge. She had recently lost her mom, which sent her further into her addiction. Megan struggled with drug addiction on and off for many years and when it came time to be released from jail, she decided to come to UGM.

Megan has thrived in the program. She has deepened her relationship with Jesus, addressed past hurts, found healing, began working at the UGM thrift store, and openly shares her story to help others and educate the community about the UGM Recovery Program. Megan plans to live next door at our UGM Aftercare Apartments when she reaches phase 5 (the last phase) of her program. Aftercare housing allows graduates to pay rent on a sliding scale according to their income and stay connected to support.
