Orchard Ridge | An Extraordinary Mission Partner



Orchard Ridge is a landmark institution that has thrived in Coeur d'Alene for over 100 years. It is Christian-based, providing housing in a loving, nurturing environment that strives to honor older adults. Orchard Ridge leadership is drawn from its member churches in the form of a 14-member Board of Directors who guide every aspect of its operations. First Pres contributes to this leadership through Warren Bakes who currently serves on the Board and Ann Johnson who is the Executive Director.

Orchard Ridge is extraordinary. Their enduring tradition of spiritual and emotional healing has changed the course of many lives -- as it did for Laura Jorgensen. Initially, Laura moved into Orchard Ridge in an Independent Living apartment where she made some great friends and lived a happy, active life. Then

tragedy struck with major health problems that required she receive more assistance, which was made available by moving her into Orchard's Memory Care section.

Under the care of nurturing staff, she quickly transformed from looking frail and "a little worse for wear" to a lively resident with a great sense of humor and mischievous twinkle in her eye. She was game for anything: dancing at musical performances, playing balloon badminton, and parading around in funny hats to amuse the staff! Her family was amazed at the change!

Laura blossomed and spent her remaining years living life with a great deal of joy in a spiritually rich home environment.

Similar stories have been repeated many times over the years since Orchard Ridge opened its doors helping our community and their families, one resident at a time.
