# Elementary school age children's clothing only

- Very gently used, no stains, discoloration, tears or holes, and working zippers
- Prefer name brands when possible
- Sweatshirts/Hoodies
- Seasonal winter clothing (coats, hats, gloves, snow pants, and boots) are welcome
- Sizes 5 to 14 in girls and boys, encourage slim and plus sizes in both boys and girls
- Girls shoe sizes 3-4, and 5-7 in women's
- Boys Shoe sizes 3-9
- Discourage short-shorts, tank tops, camisoles (not appropriate to meet school dress codes)

#### Most in need of ...

- packages of socks S, M, L
- packages of underwear 5-14 or S, M, L, XL
- boys jeans 5-14 slim, regular and plus sizes
- girls leggins (XS, X, M, L, XL)
- girls jeans 5-14 both slim, regular and plus sizes
- boys/girls long sleeved t-shirts
- Shoes: girls 3-4 and 507 (women's); boys 3-9
- Boots see above sizes
- sweaters especially girls

Care Group has taken on a special mission to ensure the Deacon's clothing drive collects sufficient Tops, Bottoms, and Toes. These most important clothing items are needed so that our local children can start the school year with new underwear and socks.

Collection boxes will be at the church during the week and in Kruger Hall on Sundays during the month of May.

#### Tops:

Girls sport bras and camisoles sizes L (10-12), XL (14-16), XXL (18-20)

#### **Bottoms:**

Girls hipster panties sizes 5-16 Boys briefs, boxer briefs, boxers sizes 5-16

#### Toes:

Girls low cut and crew cut socks sizes (7-8.5), (8-9.5), (9-11)

Boys quarter socks and crew cut socks sizes (7-8.5), (8-9.5), (9-11)

Socks should be in the children's shoe size categories of (9-2.5), (2-5.5), and (4-10)



Parents, Grandparents, Aunts, and Uncles (basically any adult) are invited to bring their 3-year old through 6-year old for pottery painting and storytime at Hands to Art! We will follow our art time with a picnic and playtime at North Pines Park (1015 E. Lunceford). Please bring a blanket and sack lunch for you and your kiddo(s).

We will meet at Hands to Art at 10:00 AM to paint adorable cross-shaped boxes with lids (littles always love places to hide their "treasures"!). We ask that you bring your own sack lunch. The cost will be \$20.

We will be following city/county COVID safety protocols. Currently, that means that masks are optional, but recommended. Staff and volunteers will be wearing masks for this event.

#### 2nd Annual 1st Pres Art Camp: July 6th - 9th, 9:30 am - 11:45 am

We are partnering with Hands to Art again this year to provide your child the opportunity to attend art camp with their church family! We will be creating five amazing masterpieces throughout the 4-day camp. Throughout the week we will be exploring what it means to be God's child, and how God views us. We will be focusing on figuring out what characteristics make us different from each other and celebrating our uniqueness through the eyes of Christ!

We will begin the day at "Hands to Art" pottery studio where the campers will complete a different art project each day. Following that, we will stay on-site to eat a sack lunch (provided by you) and discuss our topic for the day.

This camp experience is open to incoming 1st graders through current 5th graders. The total cost will be \$120, we ask that you provide your child's sack lunch daily. Drop off at 9:20 am and pick up at 11:45 am. Scholarships are available, please email Carley@1stpresdowntown for information.

We will be accepting up to 25 children for this event. We will follow city/county and school district guidelines for COVID safety protocols during this event. Currently, that would mean masks would be optional but strongly recommended for participants. All adult staff and volunteers will be wearing masks.
