

# Missions Committee Update Staff of Hope



Staff of Hope, started in 2001 by a group of seminary students in response to a severe drought in East Africa, have been a long-standing 1st Pres Mission Partner. The organization, centered in Kenya, has grown since 2001,

guided by a vision of helping people lift themselves from poverty with sustainable longterm solutions and becoming resilient to events like drought, famine, and economic shock. Staff of Hope believes that the work they do can have impact for generations. Investing in water, education, and Christian leadership today can create a more hopeful future for children in East African communities.

As a country with only a 1.9% vaccine rate for COVID-19, the Staff of Hope's mission in Kenya has been challenging and the needs are severe. Because of pandemic restrictions, the Oloile School we support has been operating on a restricted basis and Christian leadership mentoring programs have been limited. More than ever, our support for the Staff Of Hope is greatly needed.
