
Green Bluff for some family fun this Saturday!

#### Missions Committee September Report

CDAIDE was born in 2014 as part of 1st Pres' strategic vision for mission outreach in Coeur d'Alene and beyond. It was recognized that hospitality workers are some of the most vulnerable and underserved in our Coeur d'Alene, Hayden, and Post Falls community; and right in our own downtown neighborhood. Two years of development and relationship building began, resulting in CDAIDE becoming its own non-profit.

A founding board of restaurant owners and managers, 1st Pres members, community

leaders and other local churches saw the need to focus on those who barely survive during a boom and bust seasonal cycle that makes the long, slow winter months difficult.

Support may include financial aid for urgent needs, access to healthcare, connections to resources and mentoring with no strings attached. 
