

1st Pres will be hosting the Ecumenical Kitchen Lunch on Thursday, April 1. No foolin'!


We continue to provide healthy bag lunches for our guests for the time being. We share the kitchen with the NIC


38th Annual Back-to-School Clothing Giveaway August 2021

Watch again or for the 1st time!




