

How We're Responding to COVID-19 : Reminder

The Session appointed a special task force, COVID-19 Task Force, to provide research and guidance on how best to reopen the church. The Session met on May 19th to reevaluate our response based on insight from the COVID-19 Task Force. The Session approved four immediate recommendations. The Session asked the COVID-19 Task Force to provide Session with a detailed plan for services to now resume on June 21st. <u>Plan</u> <u>Approved on May 26, 2020.</u>
