## **This week's scripture:**

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> Now the earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of waters. <sup>3</sup> And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. <sup>4</sup> God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. <sup>5</sup> God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day. <sup>6</sup> And God said, "Let there be a dome between the waters to separate water from water." <sup>7</sup> So God made the dome and separated the water under the dome from the water above it. And it was so. <sup>8</sup> God called the dome "sky." And there was evening, and there was morning—the second day.
