This week's scripture

⁵ Thomas said to him, "Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?" ⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. ⁷ If you know me, you will know my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him."

Scripture Reflection Questions: Read this week's scripture together and discuss the following:

- What do we learn about God (e.g., traits, personality, what matters, priorities) in this passage?
- What do we learn about people, and ourselves in particular, this week?

Sermon Reflection Questions: Reflecting on this week's sermon, discuss the following:

- Pastor McLane said that truth is often a source of fear for people. On one hand, many fear that truth is becoming subjective (i.e. there is no truth). On the other hand, many fear the weaponization of truth. Do you resonate with any of these fears? Why or why not?
- Pastor McLane said that our posture before the living truth in Jesus Christ ought to be one of humility. What might it look like for you to humbly engage with the truth of Christ in your daily life?
